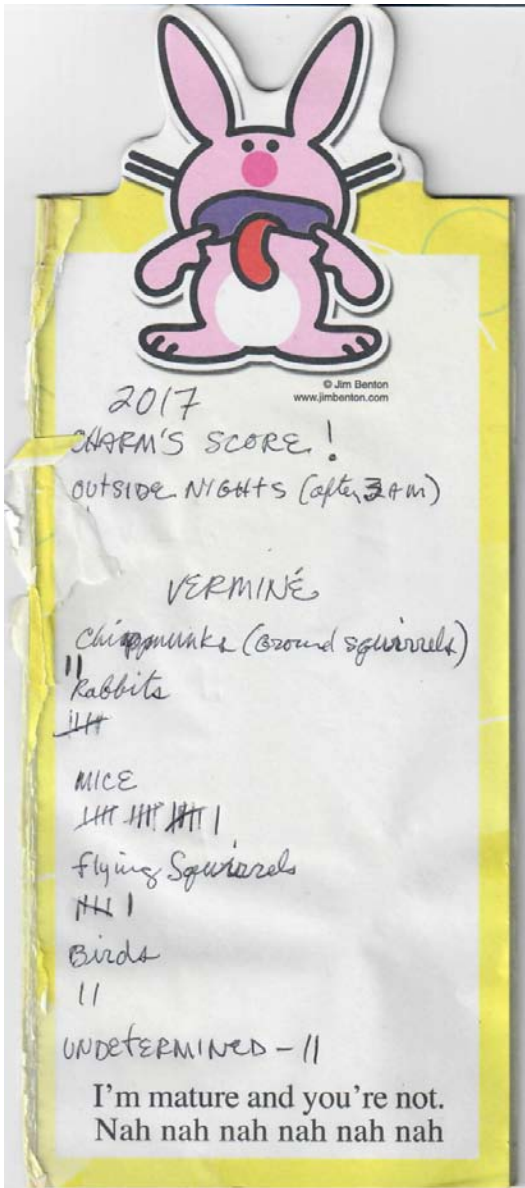
OTHER STUFF
